GE Power Systems Completes Acquisition of Bently Nevada Atlanta, GA - GE Power Systems has completed the acquisition of Bently Nevada Corp., a global leader in machinery monitoring and diagnostics. The deal was announced in November last year and does not disclose financial terms. Bently Nevada, founded in 1961, employs 2,100 people worldwide and had projected sales of \$235 million in 2001. John Rice, GE Power Systems' president and CEO, said the acquisition will provide a comprehensive portfolio of products and services to meet customers' power needs. Don Bently, Bently Nevada's founder and CEO, added that both companies' customers will benefit from the deal, bringing new technology and engineering resources into GE's growing turbine operations worldwide. As GE acquired Bently Nevada in 2002, a company with a rich history in rotor dynamics, we'd like to share five lesser-known facts about its past: 1) Donald E Bently founded his company, Bently Scientific Company, in 1956 from his garage That's right: the Bently Scientific Company was initially set up out of "Don" E Bently's garage in 1956. With a background in aviation, Bently discovered commercial uses for electronic sensing technologies and began creating eddy-current products, which eventually led to the formation of the Bently Nevada Corporation. 2) The "Bently Probe" revolutionised measuring vibration Prior to the 1960s, there was no direct way to observe vibratory motion. The "Bently probe," a common term for Bently's innovative eddy-current proximity probes, enabled users to directly assess vibration and mechanical condition on most rotating equipment over 1,000 HP. 3) GE Energy bought Bently Nevada in 2002 after it had grown significantly By the time of GE's acquisition in 2002, Bently Nevada had expanded from its humble beginnings to a global company with 100 offices in 42 countries. It employed over 2,100 people worldwide and generated \$235 million in sales. 4) The Bently Nevada 3500 series is the culmination of decades of innovation With about 50 years of history preceding it: the 5000 series (1965-1998), 1700 series (1973-1998), 9000 series (1975-2003), and 3300 series (1988-2003) all laid the groundwork for the Bently Nevada 3500 series in 1995. Each generation improved upon its predecessor, resulting in a comprehensive product. 5) GTC offers extensive inventory of Bently Nevada 3500 spares AT GTC, we maintain an extensive stock of Bently Nevada 3500 spare parts, including chassis, vibration and position cards, relay modules, speed/over speed monitors, reciprocating compressor monitors, and communication gateway. This includes both unused and remanufactured components. General Electric Power Systems Acquires Bently Nevada Corp. Bently Nevada Corp., Carson Valley's largest non-gaming employer, has been acquired by General Electric Power Systems in a deal worth between \$600 million and \$900 million. The company was founded by Don Bently in 1961 and has since grown to employ over 2,100 people worldwide, including 1,200 in Carson Valley. The acquisition is considered one of the biggest in years and marks a significant milestone for GE Power Systems.
