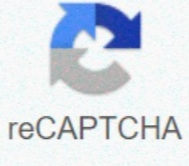

How to force factory reset android

Your Android smartphone is slow, freezing, non-reactive, responding incorrectly, or can you remember the phones password? You're in luck! There is still a rather powerful option available, and ie run a hard reset, also known as an alternative reset, on the device. Before starting ... If you are still able to access the setting on your device and browse the phone, you may be more interested in reading how to back up and reset an Android phone, which passes through the process to perform a full backup And then execute a factory data restoration through the phones settings. If you have problems accessing factory data recovery options through the settings, then you can perform a factory reset on your Android smartphone and this article will show you how to do it. This is the perfect solution if you have problems with your touch screen or you can't browse properly on your phone. It is also an option if you can't get your device to turn it down to the bottom or when your phone has not activated at all. If you are trying to reset on your Android smartphone, you are likely to know how effective a reset is to solve phones problems. Through this article I go to multiple ways to perform reset on your phone without actually having to navigate through the touch screen. Your phone doesn't even need to be turned on to do it in most cases! Make sure the device is turned off most of these rigid resets requires that the phone is completely switched off, then make sure your phone is turned off all the way as soon as it is blocked. If the phone is unable to answer and you cannot turn off the phone with the power button, then you may need to extract the battery, it counts out, then replace the battery. Only Don't Recharge the phone if you need to reinsert the battery. Keep the device off. Also make sure that the phone is not connected to a charger. If the phone is connected to a charger or if the device is not completely turned off, the reset will not work. Rigid reset methods and procedures may also differ alternative resets usually involve performing a series of key combinations we arrive in a minute. The combination of keys that you need to run a lot on the brand and model model of the phone and version of Android OS (operating system) is currently running on the device. For example, you may be able to perform a reset on a phone a way in one of the operating system 2.2 (froyo), then update the phone to the operating system 2.3 (gingerbread) and the method does not work anymore, causing you Use a different method (I have an example of this in method 6 and 7 below). When updating again to the operating system 4.0 (Sandwich ice cream) you may need to use a different method and a combination of different keys to perform the same alternative reset. So just pay attention to this. It may also be necessary to try the reset a couple of times to make it cross correctly. Disclaimer: Remember that a reset is permanent and cannot be canceled. You will delete all personal data and download the contents on the phone, do not worry that you will not influence or cancel your memory card or nothing saved on the SIM card. This includes content as images, ringtones, texts, apps, etc. And we usually will also solve software problems, bugs, viruses, etc. Try if possible, to make a backup first. Usually when you need to perform an alternative reset on your mobile phone you may not be able to back up. Preparation for a hard reset on an Android phone only a side note On a typical alternative reset so you know what to expect. You are going to turn off the phone, hold a specific set of key combinations (shown below), go to a fastboot / test / recovery screen / etc. Select RESET, and then the phone turns off, everything from itself, then you will have again, all by yourself. This can take a few minutes, some phones can take up to 15 minutes to a (Although rather rare, the average phone probably takes 3-5 minutes). When the phone is off, press and hold volume Up and Giu key volume both at the same time, then press and hold the power button until a test screen showing some appear options, usually takes about 15-20 seconds. When that screen opens you can let the keys go. Press the greet button of the volume to move down through the options until it does not highlight, then press the power button to select it. 2. Turn on the phone all the way, hold down the volume key and press the print button the power button, always holding the volume button for about 10-15 seconds. Press the Volume key down to move down through the options until it highlights the restore option; It is usually said factory, then press the power button to make the selection. 3. While turned off, press and hold the Home button, while continuing to hold down the power ignition key the device by pressing the power button. Once the Android recovery screen is displayed, release the Home button, then while on the Android restore screen, press the volume up and volume down the keys, both at the same time. Note: If the screen is not reactive I use the volume keys to scroll and the camera button to select. Select YES to delete all user data, then select OK (back to the left). Select a Nowa restart system and press OK. 5.
