Choose PNG as your required file format and call it com.apple.desktop.admin.png. Save it somewhere on your Mac. Use the Command keyboard combination + Shift + G to activate the Go to Folder menu. Copy and paste /Library/Caches into the address bar, then click Go. Copy the new image saved as "com.apple.desktop.admin.png" and paste it into the Library/Caches folder. You can use Command (⌘) + C key combination to copy and Command (⌘) + V key combination to paste. Drag or just drag the image. 3. That's it! Step out of your Mac and enjoy your new login background image. You'll also see the image you've chosen every time you turn on or restart your Mac. In case you have problems with this, it's better what to do if your Mac doesn't turn off. How to change the lock screen on macOS Sierra if you have macOS Sierra, changing your lock screen photo can be a lot more convenient. All you need to do is: Open System Preferences > Choose Desktop and Screen Saver. Check the left pane of the window to choose the photo you want to set as the new background. How to edit the login background on macOS Mojave. For macOS Mojave, you can change the background login screen by performing the following operations: CTRL + Click on the picture of the desired login screen, select Open with and choose Preview App. In the top toolbar, click the File tab and choose Save with name HEIC as a file format required. And call it mojav.heic. Save it somewhere on your Mac. Open the Finder and go to /Library/Desktop Pictures / Desktop Pictures / Catalina. Heicrate MACINVALIDATE. Open this folder and you should see a file > «Lockscreen.png». Note: If you don't have a desktop image folder on your Mac, you will need to manually create it in the cache folder. Follow these steps: 3. 1 Go to system preferences > Users & groups > > Click on the icon in the lower left corner - type in the admin password - right click on the username - choose Advanced Options - copy the UUID of your user ID. 3.2 Exit from System Preferences "to return to /Library/Caches/Desktop Pictures > create a new folder > name it with your UUID. 3.3. Next, right-click anywhere in the folder > Choose Get Info from the drop-down menu. 3.4 Recheck if Mac has writing privileges. Allow you to read and write to user, administrator and, everyone. 4. Rename image lockscreen.png (if this image is in the folder) to old-lockscreen.png. 5. Rename the image you want to have as login screen to lock the screen. png > drag-and-drop it to the open folder. 6. Restart the Mac. How to change user icons on a Mac. You can also change the default backup icons that Apple has chosen for you by doing the following: 1. Open System Preferences. 2. Click the User & Groups icon. 3. Swipe over the user icon and click Edit. 4. Choose your new image or just take a new photo using Mac cam. 5. Click Done to save changes. FAQ: How do I customize my Mac screen? To customize the Mac screen, edit the desktop image: Go to Apple menu and select System Preferences > Click Desktop & Screen Saver. From the left sidebar, select an image folder and click a favorite image. You can also customize the Mac desktop image using the Finder: Open the Finder and locate a favorite image > Click the image and select the Set Desktop Picture option from the drop-down menu. If the Set Desktop Picture option is not available, select Services and find the option there. How can I change the lock screen image on a MacBook Air? To change the lock screen image on a MacBook Air, simply change the desktop background. Since both images are linked, they will be immediately replaced with the image of your choice. Here's how to do it: Open the Photos app and locate a favorite image > Click the image and select the Set Desktop Picture option from the drop-down menu. Here's how to customize the Mac lock screen without changing the desktop background: Open a favorite image in Preview > Click the image name at the top of the screen and rename it to "lockscreen.png" > Navigate to Finder > Go > Go to Folder > Enter the path /Library/Caches/Desktop Pictures and click Go. Out of different folders, select the one containing "lockscreen.png" > Drag file and drop the favorite screen image into the folder. To make a custom screensaver on your Mac, use this method: Go to Apple menu and select System Preferences > Click Desktop & Screen Saver. On the Screen Saver tab, select a type of screensaver. From the Source menu, select Choose Folder > Browse to Favorite With images and click Choose. Set a timer for your Mac screensaver, go to the Start menu after below and select a preferred value. The screensaver after your Mac remains inactive for the selected time period. Why do my Mac continues to change my desktop wallpaper after closing? Your Mac continues to change the desktop background because you have selected the Dynamic Desktop option in the settings. To correct the problem, go to System Preferences > Desktop & Screen Saver > Desktop and Don't Peak the Edit image box. Another reason why the desktop background continues to change Mac after reboot is an external display bug. There is no way to deal with the problem different from that of disconnecting the display before turning off the Mac down. The continuously evolving desktop background could also be a software incompatibility already addressed by Apple Engineers. Therefore, if the two previous corrections do not help you, update MacOS.
