The Crosstour was offered with either a 3.5-liter V6 engine (with the option of either front-wheel or all-wheel drive) or a 2.4-liter 4-cylinder engine (with only front-wheel drive).[4] with prices that began at \$29,670. These prices were higher than those of the Accord sedan, which began at less than \$23,000. In preparation for the 2012 model year, Honda dropped the Accord prefix from the name of the vehicle, changing it to simply Crosstour, and redesigned the front grille.
