Kettle river campground

Warning: Can only detect less than 5000 characters78 is wheelchair accessible. The pad around the table is paved and there is the paved access to the site and also to the bathroom. While the cartfeams are allowed and the camp rings are provided in every campsite, we encourage visitors to preserve wood and protect the environment by minimizing the use of fire and using campsites. Firewood can be purchased in the park or you could bring your own Firewood fees are set locally and can vary from park to park. Limited operating hours or bonuses can be implemented. To preserve vegetable and earth cover, please don't collect firewood from the area around the campsite or other parts of the park (this is a crime pursuant to the Ticketable Park law). Dead wood is an important habitat element for many plants and animals and the organic matter to the ground is added. Cold water taps are located throughout the park. Faucets are turned off during the off-season. There is a large campsite in this park. The Camping Group area is accessed from the road to the day-to-date course the junction for the regular campsite. The dirt road is guarded and leads to a fenced pebble parking cycle. There is room for vehicles more than ten along the cycle, plus in the center of the cycle. That surrounds the fenced parking lot is a meadow band then open ponderosa pine / bunchgrass forest. There are 13 tables on the lawn which has the potential for tenting with a lot of shadow supplied by the ponderosa pines. There are two wire toilets, a pit toilet accessible to disabled people near parking, as well as two faucets and two fire rings. There is also a shelter Log frame half wall with concrete floor. Inside they are a hob, sink, counter and six tables. The area is located on a terrace above the river and there are benches along the edge overlooking the river. Group campsites are open from May 5th to October 1, reservations are accepted. Youth group camping group at night are \$ 1 / person (6+) with a minimum of \$ 50 and \$ 150 to the maximum. Read the young group policy on the criteria of groups of young people. Regular camping group per night are the basic rate for the site, which is \$ 120.00 / site / night group, more \$ 5 / adults (16+, minimum calculation 15 adults), more \$ 1 / child (6 -15). Children under 6 are free! This park has a day-use / picnic area located right on the beautiful kettle river. There is a pebble car park even if there are no vehicles over 24 feet or trailers due to space restrictions. There is a hand pump for water near the parking lot, as well as two pit bathrooms. Soon, 30m steps from the parking lot Bring visitors to the river and 10 picnic tables with an excellent river view. The tables are separated by shrubs and well shaded. There is a faucet near the tables. The amount of beach varies with the water level. A 2 km route follows the river. Pit and wire toilets are found throughout the park. This park has a large playground and swings. A Sani-station / unloading is available during the collection season. Drinking water is available here. Sani-station use fees: \$ 5.00 For exhaust there are hot showers in the shower building. There is no additional cost for showers and are for registered guests, only. All sites are accessible vehicle. Siti 1ã, 85 are Reservable and sites 86a 114 are for First-like, First-serving camping. There are 12 double sites located throughout the park. The sites are arranged in three main cycles. The sites are found in the beautiful, open ponderosa pine / bunchgrass forest with the red-orange bark of trees contrasts sharply with the grass bland. This type of forest gives the campsite one, a feeling of open spaciousness. The exception is the cycle of sites 21a 53, which offer a feeling of significantly different camping. These are the smallest sites that are very private and are in thick Douglas fir with many shrubs that separate the sites. The last cycle of sites 86a 114 are some of the most open places in the park. Check-in Procedures: GuestsÂ € With reservations: Â, check the booking tab at the Host campsite site for site number preassigned confirmation. GuestSÂ € Without reservation: choose any site first-like, first-need vacant (sites 86a 114) or if you are looking for a one-night stay, select any vacancy marked by a single night tag.
