All stars game results

The American League's nine-game winning streak in All-Star Games looked to continue, but Rockies catcher Elias Diaz had other plans. In the top of the eighth inning, Diaz hit a two-run home run off Felix Bautista, giving the National League its first lead and ultimately securing a 3-2 win over the AL. The National League took a 3-2 lead in the All-Star Game with a pair of big hits. Diaz crushed a two-run blast to left field, giving the National League the edge. Prior to that, Smith stole second base on Gurriel's first pitch and then worked a walk to set up the tying run at second. Meanwhile, Rooker's screamer was caught by Austin Riley, who completed an impressive double play to end the inning. The American League is now in trouble as they struggle against the National League's pitching staff. Juan Diaz bats second behind Castellanos in the eighth inning, facing Felix Bautista. The AL bullpen's second dominant arm pitches to work a nine-pitch walk against Castellanos. Castellanos scores on Jose Ramirez's double and then Rutschman hits another home run to give AL the lead. Gurriel reaches base but is initially ruled out, with Guerrero missing a ball. In the bottom of sixth, Bichette hits a deep fly to right field, scoring Perez from third. The AL now leads 2-1. Vladimir Guerrero Jr. makes a costly error on a grounder, allowing Jorge Soler to reach base. Nick Castellanos is then retired on back-to-back strikeouts. The Orioles' Yennier Cano takes the mound for the American League in the bottom of the fifth inning. Justin Steele gets a quick out against Garcia before taking over on the mound. Carlos Estevez pitches a perfect top of the fifth, striking out Juan Soto and Arcia on changeups. He then faces Carroll and retires him on three pitches to end the frame. In the bottom of the fourth, Freeman makes an impressive snag on a hard grounder to first, securing the out and ending the inning. Bo Bichette is replaced at shortstop by Luis Arraez. Luis Arraez reaches second base after being ruled safe on a steal attempt, but the call is later overturned. He then hits a slow roller that Austin Riley bare-hands at third, which he throws over to first for an out. Arraez eventually gets on base again and drives in J.D. Martinez with a hit to right field, tying the game at 1-1. Arenado hits a hard ball but grounds it out to end the inning. The game remains tied at 1-1 heading into the bottom of the fifth. Josh Jung pops out to center on the top of the third inning. Josiah Gray pitches for the National League now. The stadium is buzzing with Mariner George Kirby on the mound for the American League All-Stars. Gray spins a 1-2-3 inning, getting Semien to ground to third to end the bottom third. Jonah Heim gets called out on a strikeout after chasing a breaker in the dirt from Gray. Semien due up again, but Josh Jung pops out to center to leadoff the bottom of the third. Betts chases the slider down and away for the third out, NL still held off the scoreboard. Freeman earns a walk on a fastball just above the strike zone with two outs and Freeman on first. The curveball gets Acuna swinging for the second out. Freddie Freeman's reaction to Randy Arozarena's catch was hilarious, saying "Not fair!" and then adding "He says he's sorry... OH AND HE'S RUNNING" . Gerrit Cole started the All-Star Game with a filthy knuckle curve that got Shohei Ohtani chasing for strike three. Marcus Semien hit a grounder to Nolan Arenado at third, who handled it easily to start the bottom half of the inning. Mookie Betts grounded out to second, and Cole dodged some hard-hit balls, including one with an expected batting average of .570 that would have been a home run in Yankee Stadium. Adolis Garcia made an incredible leaping catch against the wall to secure the first out, robbing Ronald Acuña Jr. of a hit. Randy Arozarena also made a stellar catch in left field, robbing Freddie Freeman of a hit.
