Do you keep getting redirected to the login page when trying to log into your Epic Games account? Sometimes, users experience login issues on Epic Games for various reasons, such as browser cache interference, account-specific problems, not verifying an account after creation, or issues with the client. Here are a few steps you can take to fix the problem and log in successfully. 1. Check if Epic Games servers are down. First, go to the Epic Games status page to see if all systems are working properly. If there are any backend issues, wait for Epic Games to fix them, and the login issue should be resolved automatically. Sometimes, Epic Games doesn't display an error message even after a failed login attempt. Before trying other solutions, ensure you're entering the correct login information. If you haven't saved the login credentials in your browser, try different combinations to sign in, especially if you have doubts. However, if you keep the login information saved in your browser and it's being entered correctly, proceed to the next step. If you recently created an Epic Games account and have trouble logging in, ensure you've verified your account through the confirmation email received when creating the account. If you haven't verified your Epic Games account yet, log into your email account, find the verification email from Epic Games, and follow the instructions to verify it. If your login credentials are correct and your account has already been verified, rule out browser issues. Most users who encountered this problem resolved it by clearing the browser's cache, logging in from an incognito window, or switching to another browser. Clear your cache in Chrome, Edge, Firefox, or any other browser you're using, turn off any extensions that could interfere with the login process, or open an incognito window and sign in from there. If none of these attempts work, switch to a different browser and try logging into your Epic Games account there. If you can successfully sign in on another browser, there's likely a problem with your primary browser. Therefore, abandon it and switch to another browser where you are able to access your Epic Games account. Clearing Epic Games Launcher Cache Fixes Issues on Windows To resolve an issue with the launcher immediately, consider deleting the webcache folders in the Saved folders. First, press Win+R and type "%appdata%" to access the folder. Navigate to Local > EpicGamesLauncher > Saved folders and delete any webcache folders found here. If clearing the cache doesn't work, you need to repair the launcher by referring to our guide on repairing apps and programs in Windows 11. This may resolve issues caused by corrupted files. Repairing the launcher is not sufficient; reinstalling the client can also solve the problem. However, this may take some time. Before reinstalling, follow our uninstallation guide for Epic Games launcher and delete all existing folders at C:\Users\AppData\Local. Upon reinstalling, go to Epic Games' official website to download and install the launcher as initially done.
