Storing offline pages Enter a copy of the page to the hard disk so that you can view from the default browser when you are ready. You can save Internet pages for offline purposes in many of the main web browsers, such as Internet Explorer and Mozilla Firefox. Open your Internet browser. Switch to the web page you want to save for offline use. Click the "File" menu if you use Mozilla Firefox and the "Page" menu in Internet Explorer. Click the "Check the current page icon" if you use Google Chrome. Click the "Save as" option or "Save page as". Type the desired file name in the "File Name" section or type nothing in this section to leave the default title. In the "Save as type" box, click "Web page, complete" if you want to save the entire offline page, including graphics and sound or "web archive, single file" if you just want a html html of the Page from which you can read the text of the page. Click the "Save" button. Double-click the saved file to open it at any time you are "Working offline" or disconnected from the Internet and want to view the saved web pages. Google Chrome allows you to download complete web pages for offline viewing. You can only save the basic HTML or additional resources (such as images) to completely reassemble a page without the need for an internet connection. How to save a web page Go ahead and shoot Chrome, then go to a web page you want to save. Click the Menu button, then click Other Tools> Save page as. Alternatively, you can use CTRL + S (Command + S in MacOS) to open a "Save" dialog box. Choose a folder to save the page and then, from the drop-down menu, choose "Webpage, HTML only" or "Webpage, complete."
